

### **Public Safety Institute – EMR**

Fee: \$285

IMPORTANT: Pre-registration, with payment, required 2 weeks before the program starts.

### Description

The EMR course prepares students with the knowledge and skills to provide basic level emergency care in a pre-hospital setting. This course is aligned with the National Education Standards for EMR as approved by the PA DOH (Pennsylvania Department of Health). Student will learn emergency care for cardiac arrest, medical emergencies, trauma emergencies, patient assessment techniques, oxygen administration and EMS Operations. Students must be able to meet all requirements for the Functional Position Description for EMR. The course will include classroom sessions and skill labs

### **Prerequisites**

Course participants must be at least 16 years of age at the first-class session. All students must meet the Functional Position Description for EMR. These include vision and hearing acuity as well as reading/writing and physical abilities. A complete list will be furnished to all students at the first-class session. If you need the Functional Position Description or ADA Accommodation Policy prior to registration, call 412.237.2500.

### Co-requisite

Students must complete the FEMA independent study course for NIMS 100 and 700 online and the Hazardous Material Awareness course online as a co-requisite to this course. Students who successfully complete the course will be eligible for PA DOH certification exams for EMR. Certificates that were obtained prior to the course will be accepted but must be less than 1 year old. Information to these courses will be handed out on the first night of class

### **Certification Testing**

Students who successfully complete the College EMR program will be required to take the National Registry Psychomotor Exam (practical skill) that will be scheduled during the EMR class. Students who are not able to attend the scheduled exam will have to contact EMS West at 412.242.7322 or <a href="www.emsi.org">www.emsi.org</a> to make arrangements to schedule their psychomotor exam (practical skill). Once a student successfully passes the psychomotor exam (practical skill), will then be eligible to register on the NREMT website <a href="www.nremt.org">www.nremt.org</a> for the written exam which is taken at a Pearson Vue testing center. The cost of the exam is \$88 that is paid directly to Pearson Testing which is the students' responsibility.
